ORDER

In a Memorandum Opinion and Order dated and filed on October 22, 2014, Chief Judge McKee dismissed the complaints in the above matter.

The Judicial Council has considered the petition for review and has concluded that the relief requested should be denied and the order of Chief Judge McKee should be affirmed for the reasons set forth in his Memorandum Opinion.
