ORDER

In a Memorandum Opinion and Order dated and filed on May 11, 2021, Chief Judge Smith dismissed the complaint in the above matter.

Complainant filed a petition for review by the Judicial Council of the Third Circuit on May 25, 2021.¹

The Judicial Council considered the petition for review and concludes that the relief requested should be denied and the order of Chief Judge Smith should be affirmed for the reasons set forth in his Memorandum Opinion.

¹ Complainant contends that she has filed complaints against all of the active judges of the Court of Appeals (among other judges), but as explained in Chief Judge Smith's Memorandum and Opinion, this is incorrect. In any event, the members of the Judicial Council decline to be disqualified pursuant to Rule 26, *Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings*.

Pursuant to Rule 19, Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability

Proceedings, it is therefore ORDERED that the May 11, 2021 order of Chief Judge Smith

is AFFIRMED.
