The following order is issued in the interests of moving cases to calendaring and final disposition in a timely manner.

If counsel in a case fails to comply with a court order or rule, the clerk will issue a show cause order directing counsel to either comply with the court order or rule or to appear before the attorney-hearing officer to explain the failure. The attorney-hearing officer will endeavor to assist counsel in complying with the court order or rule. If counsel complies with the order or rule, the attorney-hearing officer will discharge the show cause order. If counsel fails to comply, the attorney-hearing officer will set the matter for hearing before the next available judge of this court for possible imposition of sanctions.
